

Reservation Info

Site number is not guaranteed and may be subject to change without notice.

Reservations require 2 night minimum (3 nights on holidays). No show reservations will be cancelled at noon of the date following scheduled arrival & deposit forfeited. Rates are subject to change without notice. Management reserves the right to cancel reservations upon refund of your full deposit paid.

RESERVATION CANCELLATIONS or DATE CHANGES: Reservation deposits paid per site are not refundable. Credit towards future camping (up to 5 years) shall be given with advance notice as follows:

- Camping Reservations with \$75 deposit: **(1)** Notice of 14 days or more ahead: **\$60 credit**.
- **(2)** Notice of 7 days or more ahead: **\$40 credit**. **(3)** Notice of less than 7 days ahead: **No credit**.
- For Group Camping Reservations, or Rental Cabins, Trailers or Patio Boats, a notice of 14 days or more ahead is required to receive any credit of deposits paid.

Entry gate is locked each night, visit www.collinslake.com for hours. For late arrivals, call in advance to make arrangements.

CAMPING CHECK-IN TIME: 2PM CABINS/RENTAL TRAILERS: 4PM CHECK-OUT TIME: NOON

CAMPING FEES INCLUDE 1 VEHICLE PER SITE. (see rates for extra vehicles).

Only 1 extra vehicle from same household may register per site and must park on camp pad or in extra vehicle parking lot.

Campsite max: 6 people, including children.

Early Departures

For early departures, 2 days notice (by noon) must be given for refunds. For less notice, a credit will be given towards future camping.

Boat Docks & Marina Slip Rentals

Use boat docks & marina slip rentals at your own risk. The marina surface may be wet or icy – watch your step. Collins Lake does not provide insurance coverage for boats and equipment at Marina, and is not responsible for damage or loss. If you note any problem with the berth, report it immediately to the office before using berth; otherwise you are accepting that the berth to be in good, safe condition. It is recommended that you tie your boat securely with four ½" ropes and four rubber bumpers. In the event of wind or rains, check your boat and take out of water at launch ramp for your protection. You give Collins Lake permission, if necessary, to move, re-tie or bail out your boat at your cost and liability.

Campfire Safety

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR OWN CAMPFIRE. NEVER LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED. KEEP FIRES SMALL

Fire must be contained within the fire box provided with your campsite or your fire barrel large enough to contain the fire. Be sure there is a 10' clearance around and above your fire of all vegetation. There must be either water or a shovel kept near the fire at all times. Use added caution whenever hot, dry and/or windy conditions elevate the fire risk above the Moderate risk level on the park signs in the park. Any person who allows a camp fire to escape from their fire box or barrel is liable for any loss to life or property caused by the fire (H&SC 13007 & 13008). This includes, but is not limited to the cost of fire suppression, rescue and EMS responding to fire. Payment of camping fees and/or burn barrel rental fees to Collins Lake does not transfer your responsibility to manage your own campfire responsibly.

Terms & Conditions

In granting permission to use Collins Lake and adjoining recreation areas and facilities, COLLINS LAKE, COLLINS LAKE MGMT. CORP., PINELAND DEVELOPMENT CO., AND BROWNS VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT are not responsible for injury, theft, loss or damage to any person or property or for tying down, securing and protecting boats and other property at docks, camps, parking areas and other recreation areas. Parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children.

No lifeguards are provided, and it is understood and agreed that registrant and his family members and guests swim and use the waters of Collins Lake and the adjoining facilities of the recreation area at their own risk.

It is understood and agreed that in consideration of the issuance of this registration, registrant will be solely responsible for, and shall protect, defend, indemnify and save COLLINS LAKE, COLLINS LAKE MGMT. CORP., PINELAND DEVELOPMENT CO., AND BROWNS VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT free and harmless from and against, any claim, demand or liability for any loss, damage or injury sustained to the person or property of registrant, his or her spouse, family or guests.

Registrant agrees to abide by and comply with all laws, rules and regulations applicable to Collins Lake Recreation Area and understands that any infraction of any people in the registrant's party shall be cause for revocation of this registration and removal from the area and/or arrest and punishment as provided by law.

Registrant understands that pursuant to Civil Code 799.23 and 799.24, a recreational vehicle may be removed from the park if the owner or operator, who has been an occupant of the park for less than 30 days, has either failed to pay for his/her occupancy in the park, or failed to comply with the rules and regulations of the park.
